General Summary:

Perform research involving basic and translational studies in retinal disease. Participate in studies aimed especially at focusing on cell based models of retinal degeneration and approaches toward

elucidating the molecular and genetic pathogenesis of retinitis pigmentosa. Implement high throughput cellular screening assay using small molecules and RNA interference. Assist in the management of research projects in the lab utilizing training in molecular biology, cell biology, and genetics. Carry out experiments under the direct supervision of the principal investigator in conjunction with his collaborators. Additional roles include supporting PI, managing staff, and participating in grant preparation.

Essential Functions:

- 70% Perform research involving basic and translational studies in retinal disease.
- 15% Participate in the preparation of manuscripts for publication, institutional review board materials and/or submission as part of grant applications.
